- Name local resources for victims of domestic violence, and be able to make appropriate referrals

Trainers

Naomi Faszczyk, MA, is the Bilingual Community Educator for Lutheran Settlement House's Bilingual Domestic Violence Program. Ms. Faszczyk has 15 years of bilingual teaching experience. She has designed and led workshops on various topics, working closely with age groups ranging from toddlers to adult populations. Ms. Faszczyk organizes and co-facilitates the BDVP's weekly support groups in English, and provides hotline and crisis counseling for survivors. Ms. Faszczyk's experience also includes work with detained city youth and stress management for after-school teachers and service providers.

Susanna Gilbertson, MSW is the Training and Education Supervisor for Lutheran Settlement House's Bilingual Domestic Violence Program. Ms. Gilbertson has created and facilitated interactive workshops on topics including sexual health, suicide prevention and intimate partner violence for youth, professional and community groups for over 13 years. Ms. Gilbertson's experience includes work in an emergency domestic violence shelter, medical social work with homebound patients, supervision of a peer help line for teenagers and facilitation of a group using interactive theater to teach young people about HIV/AIDS.
